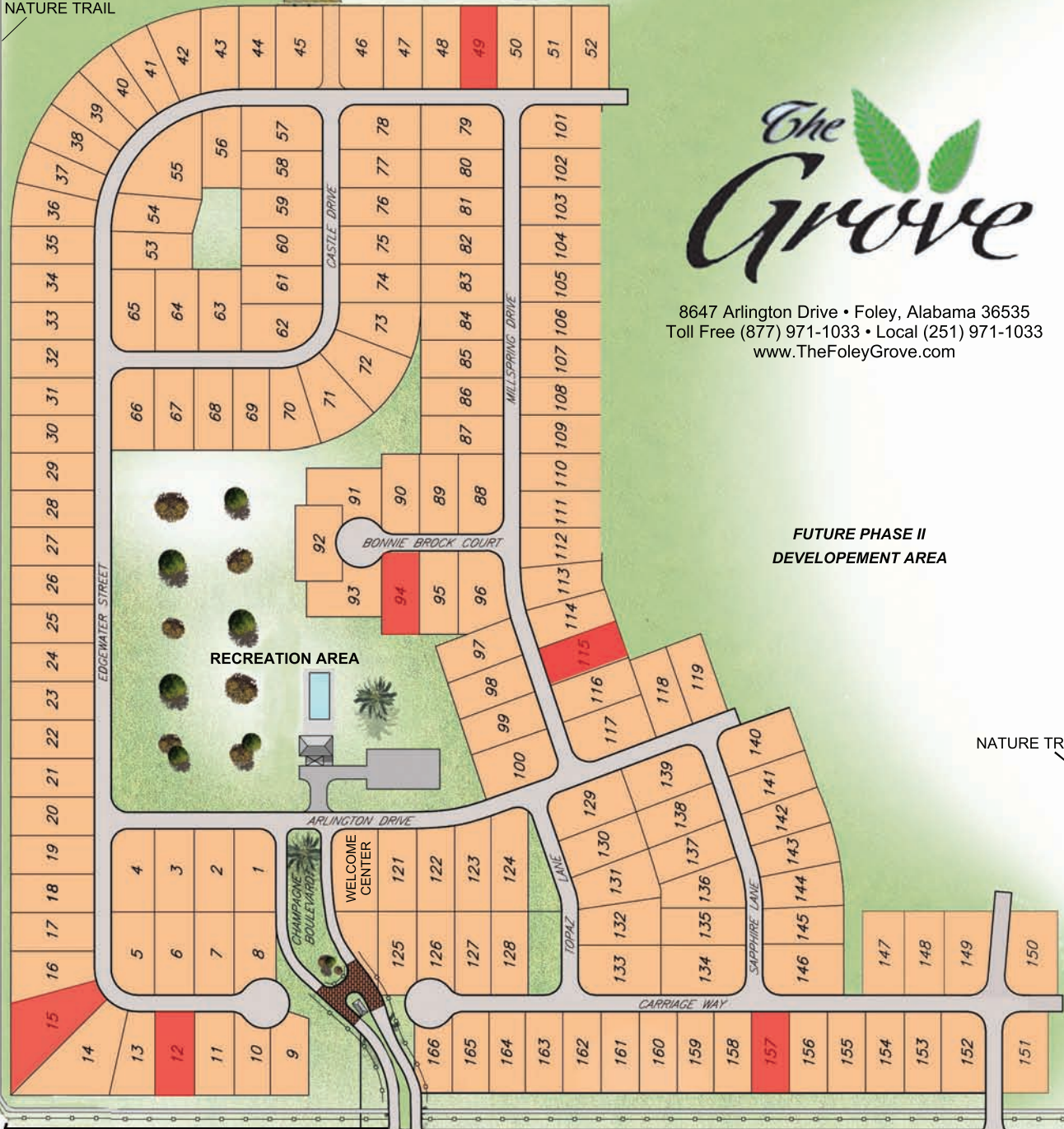

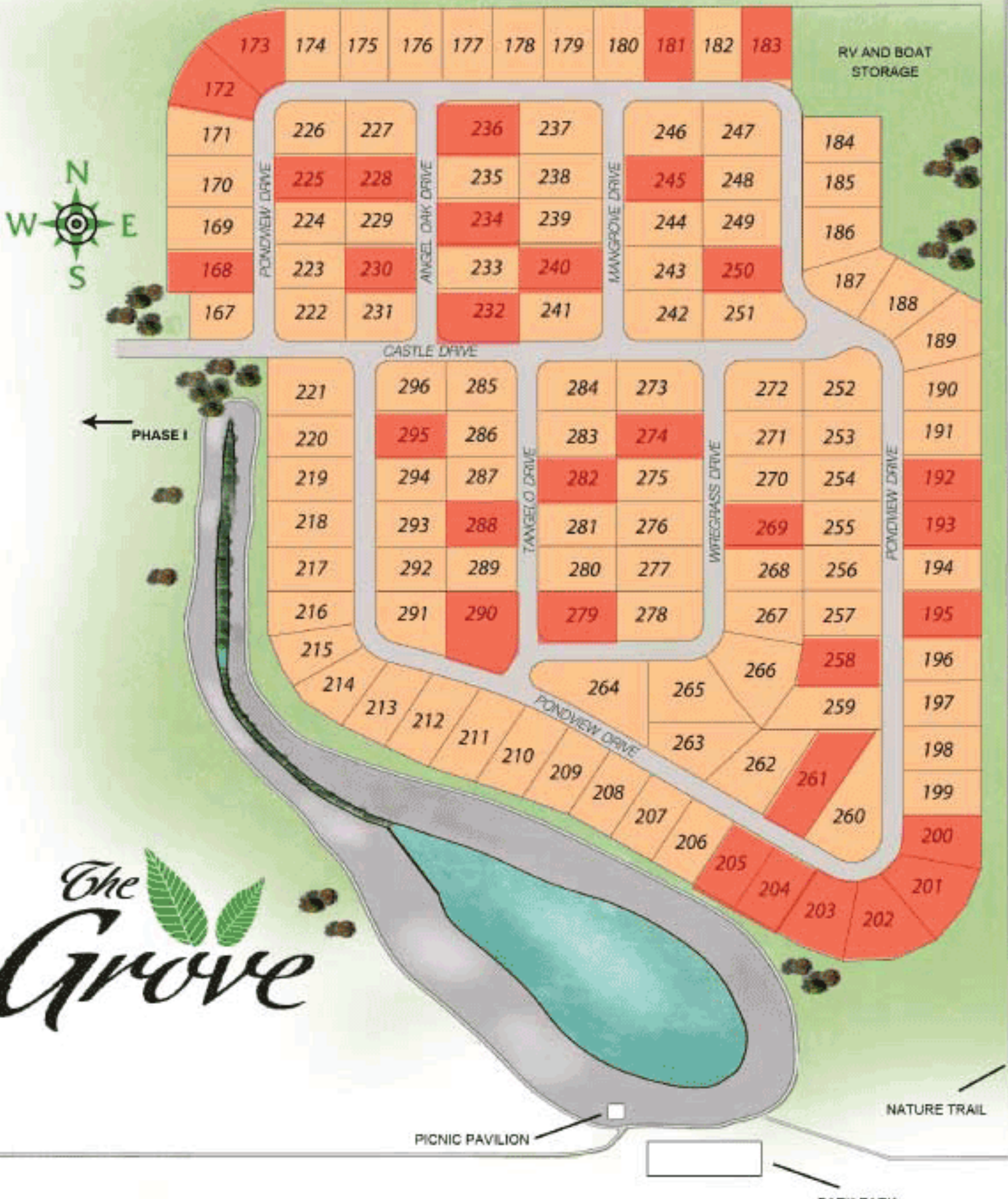

MAP AND PICTURES OF OUR NEW PHASE II (Highlighted areas are sold or are models)

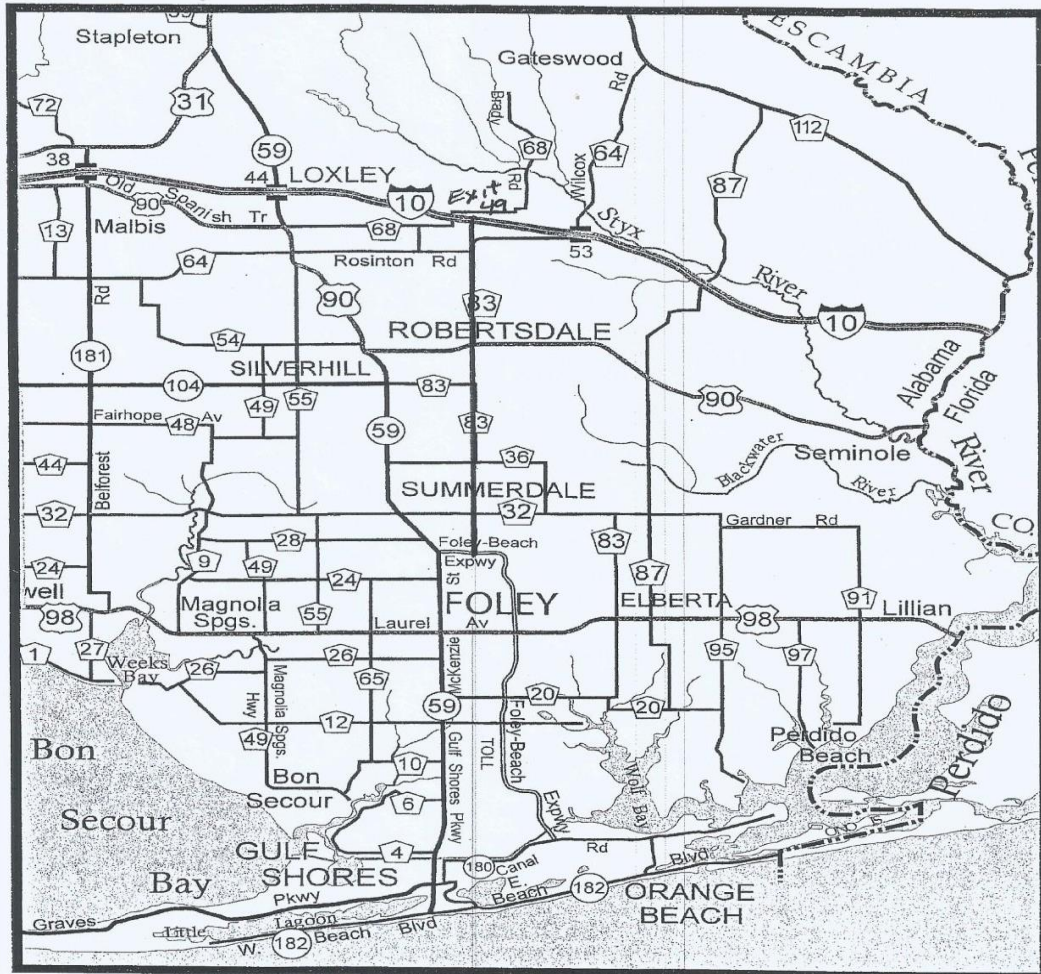

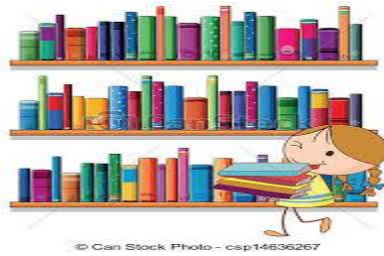
