GROVE VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES MEETING

Thursday, January 3, 2019 1:00 pm. The New Clubhouse

This group is affiliated with the Alzheimer's Foundation of America (AFA) and their purpose is to provide free and confidential memory screening and balance testing. They will be at the Grove on Tuesday, January 22 from 9:00 am -12:00 pm. They discussed their services and credentials and encouraged all Grovers to participate. <u>USO Event</u> – Althia gave a follow-up report on the funds raised at the USO Event in November. A Navy vet who lives in Robertsdale was given \$400 toward his electric bill, a \$100 gift card for Walmart, and some cash. There is still \$429 left to give either to him or to another vet in need. A vote was taken and it was decided to give it to an Army vet who lives in Silverhill. (These funds are not included in the Grovers Fund report.)

<u>Clubhouse TV</u> – Cable has now been installed in the Clubhouse. Clemson vs. Alabama on January 7, 2019.

Use of Grovers' Fund and Clubhouse Events – Discussion was held about using money from the Grovers' Fund. There was particular concern about some costs for Dirty Santa, Christmas Dinner, and New Year's Eve party. There seemed to be a consensus that large events, particularly with music (a band or DJ) need more advance planning in order to book the entertainment and raise the money to pay for it, such as, with advance ticket sales. Therefore, it was decided not to pursue a Winter Wonderland dance on January 26; there is not enough time to do so. We should be planning a Spring Fling dance instead.

Patty expressed concern about the Clubhouse not being used to its fullest potential. She stated that management could rent it to outside groups and the income would be given to the
